REPORT ON SUVARNAM (NSS SPECIAL CAMP)

Suvarnam 2019 (Seven Days Special Camp 2019 - 20) General Objective: Making education more relevant to the present situation to meet the felt needs of the communities and supplement the education of College students by bringing them face to face with the community situations. Specific Objectives: 1) To conduct the house visits and Field survey as part of the 'Harithagramam Project'. 2) To assist the House construction work.

The annual camp of NSS Unit of Santhigiri College was conducted from 07th to 13th September 2019 at St. Sebastian's HSS, Purapuzha. 
