




Mental Health Awareness Week Celebration


The mental health week was conducted on 4 days, which was organized on










WEC and Gender Equity Cell

students. Chief guest Mr. Babu Kuriakose had distributed the first prize of the Kerala Piravi Quiz Competition, students of the college were












Thodupuzha; covered of distance 3.5 kms in Thodupuzha Town and returned back to the same venue.

that, adding flavor to the function, there was a band performance from 'ASTRA 13' team.










Blood donation camp in association with IMA






Star of Santhigiri 2023








The topic for the debate is "Need Retirement in Politics?", and the event
