## THEATRE WORKSHOP



Mr. Shanavas A, Sub Judge and Secretary of District Legal Service Authority, Idukki officially inaugurated the event and addressed the audience. Rev. So far completed, breast cancer detection programme at Karimannoor gramapanchayath on 7<sup>th</sup> January 2023, An awareness class on Use of Menstrual Cup and its free distribution at Palakuzha Panchayath on 21<sup>st</sup> January 2023 and An awareness session on screen addiction and its effects on mental health at Thirumarady panchayath on 23<sup>rd</sup> January 2023.

Department of Social work oraganised **Unarvu 2022** a five days Rural camp from 9 th January to 13rd January at Kalvary Mount, Idukki District. Rural camp is one of the important pedagogical dimensions or components in field work which provides opportunities to experience the rural life, socio-eco-politico-cultural life, analyze rural dynamics, and observe the functioning of local self-government (Panchayat) and its power dynamics. Rural camp involves students in participation in planning and designing action activities for themselves and those for rural people and also helps in developing practical skills to carry out interventions, evaluate, and finally document the rare handy experience. Students actively involved in conducting surveys, Sramdhan and other developmental activities.

## **SWASTHA 2022**

Cancer awareness and screening for women was organized by department of social work in association with Palakuzha Grama Panchayath ,Rotary Club Koothattukulam and Smitha Memorial Hospital Koothattukulam .The objective of this programmis to Create cancer awareness and remove the stigma and fear attached. Help people recognize the early signs and symptoms of cancer, Free mammogram drive at AIMS on 26 February 2022thus enabling them

to seek treatment at an early stage. The program was inaugurated by Rev Fr Paul Parakattel CMI in the presence of Smt. Jaya K.S, President Palakuzha Gram panchayath, Rtn. Dr Anil John and doctors and staff from Smitha Memorial Hospital, Thodupuzha. The screening was conducted for women above 40 years of age. 114 women attended the camp and 24 women were referred for mammogram.



## INSTALLATION OF ROTARY COMMUNITY CORPS

Installation of Rotary Community Corps on 18 th January 2022. A Rotary Community Corps(RCC) is a group of people who share our commitment to changing the world through service projects. An RCC is a team of men and women who aren't Rotarians but who work in partnership with Rotary clubs to improve their communities. They can be leveraged in every stage of a project, from conducting community assessments to project planning, implementation, and monitoring and evaluation. Department of social work in association with Rotary Club agreed to conduct the future endevours under the banner of RCC. Free mammogram drive at Amritha Institute of Medical Science on 26 February 2022. Department of Social work in association with Rotary Club Koothattukulam and CANCURE foundation organized free mammogram test for Women suspected of malignancy after screening from SWASTHA 2022 .20 women who was referred from SWASTHA attended the camp.





## MENSTRUAL HYGIENE AND REPRODUCTIVE HEALTH

Department organized an Awareness class on Menstrual Hygiene and Reproductive Health on February 28 for the students of Santhigiri College. The objective of this awareness class was towards the youth that Adolescent period is very important for females as it is a transition phase characterized by rapid physical growth, psychological and behavioral changes. Public health awareness program should be developed to create awareness among adolescent girls and boys regarding menstrual hygiene and also about sexual health so that they can manage these issues with confidence and dignity and improve their quality of life.

## **JAGRATHA 2022**

## THEATRE WORKSHOP

Three days Theatre workshop was organized by Department of Social Work from 16 th to 18 th May 2022 for 4 th semester social work students. The objective was to build intellectual and aesthetic understanding of the craft and technique of theatre arts. To develop an appreciation of and respect for the various roles/aspects inherent within the theatrical process. To explore the diversity of theatre and its intersection with community, culture and society.



## **EDAMALAKUDY SURVEY AND INTERVENTION (MARCH 2019 AND MAY 2019)**

Social Work Department, Santhigiri College of Social Sciences was approached by the Child Welfare Committee, Kerala State Government, in order to carry out a comprehensive survey focusing on the children in Edmalakudy. 42 students from Santhigiri College (28 students of Semester 2 MSW batch and 14 NSS volunteer students) along with 7 faculty members set out to

complete a survey on the 21st March 2019 which last three days and covered 26 Tribal settlements all of which is located in a protected but remote forest area covering 35000 acres of deep forest within the Western Ghats.

Following on from the survey an intervention took place on the 19<sup>th</sup> May- 21<sup>st</sup> May 2019 to alleviate some of the identified causes, Department of Social Work along with the support of Edamalakudy Grama Panchayat planned and executed an intervention phase. This phase covered 7 settlements and carried out door to door awareness programmes, cleaned and painted 3 schools and painted 5 anganwaadis and direct work carried out to ensure that drop out students returned to their respective education provision.



## **EE PUZHA OZHUKATTE (Cleaning of Waterbodies)**

As part of conscientizing younger generation about the importance of preserving our Nature and ensuring a safe drinking water Department of social work of Santhigiri College initiates in cleaning water bodies of our home Panchayath in association with Local Self Government Department.



## **SWARAM (Social Work Association Reaching All Minds) Investiture (July 2019)**

On the 17<sup>th</sup> July 2019 Investiture of SWARAM was graced by Chief Guest- Mr. Joseph Agustine, Chairman Child Welfare Committee, Idukki District. He spoke about the relevance of committed social workers and wished the association all success. The Department of Social Work flagged off the theme for the current year's activities to be Human Rights. This defined the nature of the department's co-curricular and extension activities for the upcoming year.



## **WORKSHOP ON SOCIAL AUDIT (JULY 2019)**

SWARAM in association with the Kerala Social Audit Society conducted a one day workshop for both the batches of MSW (57 students) on the Social Audit Process. The course was delivered by the district resource persons for Kerala Audit Society and aims at developing MSW students to undertake live social audits on behalf of the Kerala Social Audit Society across selected panchayats in Idukki District. This will provide students an opportunity to be part of an important government initiated activity and helps them to clearly understand and evaluate some of the processes and procedures involved in live social welfare schemes there by enriching their professional growth.



## FLOOD RELIEF WORK AT KUTTAMPUZHA (AUGUST 2019)

The S1 MSW students initiated flood relief activities at Kuttampuzha near Kothamangalam on the 12<sup>th</sup> August 2019 following on from the heavy monsoon where by parts of Kerala faced severe flooding consecutively for the second year. The activity involved cleaning flood debris from nearly 15 houses one anganwadi, Public Health Centre and interacting with the people affected by this disaster. The students also incorporated students from the various batches across the college.





# WORKSHOP ON BASIC LIFE SUPPORT, BLOOD GROUP IDENTIFICATION AND BLOOD BANK CONSTITUTION (AUGUST 2019)

On the 21<sup>st</sup> August 2019, as part of the on going extension programme on partnering with the local hospitals, MSW Department and NSS Unit of Santhigiri College in association with Chazhikattu Hospital organized a half day workshop on Basic Life Support and blood group identification programme for the students of MSW and selected volunteers of NSS unit. Santhigiri College is empowering the Santhigirians to improve their social commitment by supporting people in emergency life support situations.



## **DHWANI 2019 (AUGUST 2019)**

Department of Social Work showcased a one-day Street Play called Dhwani 2019 covering Santhigiri College, Muvattupuzha Bus Stand, St. Joseph's College Vazhakulam, Vazhakulam Bus Stand, Pala Bus Stand, Karimkunnam Bus Stand and the tour concluded at the Thodupuzha Private Bus Stand. The theatre aimed to enlighten the general public on contemporary Human Rights issues and concluded with a message and leaflet distribution on how to practically respond to such violations that happen across our society. This theme based activity helped the students to understand the relevance of street theatre in empowering themselves and the general public in initiating action against social atrocities.





## **UNARVU 2019 (SEPTEMBER 2019)**

One of the highlights of the MSW programme is the rural camp which is a co-curricular activity. This year based on the Human Rights Theme, the camp was set up at Anakulam in Mankulam Grama panchayat from the 21<sup>st</sup> September to 28<sup>th</sup> September 2019. The camp organised and attended by the S1 MSW Students focused on the local health issues, resilience building in children and tribal welfare. In addition to the above the camp also delivered community based activities such road improvement, entertainment programmes for the community and community living. The camp enhances a social work students' awareness to social issues and helps to design need based activities with the support of the community.





## **ECOPRENEURSHIP (OCTOBER 2019)**

The students and staff of both batches of MSW attended a half day workshop on 3<sup>rd</sup> October 2019 was conducted by the NSS unit in association with the Purapuzha Grama Panchayath. The programme was graced by honourable MLA Mr. PJ Joseph. The class was conducted by the

chairman and founder of Green Living School, Mr. Saajeev Vijayan. MSW department was initiated into a Waste Management and Segregation Campaign with an aim of developing training to deliver waste management programmes locally. Training on Waste Management and Segregation at Source by Mr. Saajeev Vijayan was organized by the Department of Social Work and NSS unit in association with the Haritha Kerala Mission on the 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2019 to initiate a comprehensive waste management and segregation at source in the Purapuzha Grama Panchayat.





## A DAY AT IDUKKI DISTRICT JAIL MUTTOM (OCTOBER 2019)

As part of the Human Rights activities, both batches of MSW students received an opportunity to spend a day with the inmates of the Idukki District Jail as part of their Jail Day Celebrations. Students performed cultural programmes and interacted with people who were within the correctional facility.
